



**Health Screening Online Form**

What should I do when	I receive my child's test results?
what you should do nes are negative, this mean negative results (called	ts are positive, please contact your child's doctor immediately to review the test results and discuss t. You must keep your child at home and should inform your child's school. If your child's test results is that the virus was not detected in your child's specimen. Tests <u>sometimes</u> produce incorrect "false negatives") in people who have COVID-19. #### **NYCSA Parent Portal**



There is a new way for you to stay connected to your student's education and more in the new NYC Schools Account (NYCSA) Portal. One sign-in will allow you to:

- See your students grades, test scores and more in My Student
- · Take classes in Parent University
- · Report bullying
- · Access forms for your child
- · Reset your child's DOE account password



In the next few months, more features will be added making this a true one stop for parent facing information to support student learning.

You can also sign the COVID consent form, fill out emergency contact information and stay better connected to your school, your PA/PTA and your District Parent Leadership.

You can sign up for an account by entering a few basic details. This will allow you to begin receiving notifications from the DOE. It only takes five minutes, and it is the first step in getting a full account.





